



Coaches Code of Conduct

Applicable to all Coaches & Assistant Coaches of CJFC

Coaches & Assistant Coaches

1. Remember that junior football is about enjoyment of the game and player development
2. Maximise fun and put winning in perspective within a positive learning environment
3. Ensure that players understand what playing in a team means
4. Ensure the players are being taught the basic skills of the game
5. Develop team respect for opponents, umpires, coaches and team officials
6. Be prepared to lose at times for the development of the players
7. Give all players a reasonable amount of playing time and in a variety of positions
8. Keep up to date with coaching developments including coaching accreditation
9. Reject the use of performance enhancing substances in sport and abide by the guidelines set out in the AFL Drug Policy
10. Must have a current Working with Children Certification (WWCC), signed (current) YJFL Coaches Code of Conduct and AFL Level 1 and/or Foundation Coach accreditation
11. Must be registered with CoachAFL (<https://coach.afl>)
12. Maintain an Everproof account for the purpose of recording and managing their coaching qualifications
13. Be familiar with all CJFC Club Policies including, but not limited to, Principals & Values, Racial and Religious Tolerance, Equal Game Time, Team Composition and Complaints Policy
