



Coaching Requirements

Applicable to all Coaches & Assistant Coaches of CJFC

All CJFC Coaches & Assistant Coaches must:

1. Set-up and maintain an Everproof account (www.everproof.com). Coaches must use Everproof to maintain a current record of all relevant qualifications and certifications. If you already have an Everproof account, it must be linked to CJFC. If you do not have an Everproof account, an account will be created for you (email address required) and you will receive an email asking you to take ownership of the account. Note: the use of Everproof is a YJFL requirement, and non-compliance will result in the club being fined.
2. Have a current working with children check (WWCC). Note: the WWCC is free-of-charge for all volunteers - www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au
3. Read and sign the YJFL Coaches Code of Conduct. The Code of Conduct must then be counter-signed by the CJFC President or Secretary and uploaded to Everproof (<https://www.yarrajfl.org.au/wp-content/uploads/2017/06/Coaches-Code-of-Conduct.pdf>). Note: the YJFL requires that the Coaches Code of Conduct be signed every season ie. the 2018 form is not current for the 2019 season.
4. Register with CoachAFL (<https://coach.afl>). In doing so, you will be required to agree to abide by the AFL Coaches Code of Conduct and may be required to complete additional on-line education. Note: Renewal is required annually (any associated fee will be reimbursed by CJFC upon proof of payment).
5. Have Foundation AFL coaching accreditation. Foundation courses are accessed through CoachAFL. Junior, Youth and Senior Foundation courses are available, and are completed on-line. Additional learning modules (eg. Concussion) may also be required as part of the Foundation accreditation. The Foundation on-line accreditation has replaced AFL Level 1 (those with Level 1 AFL accreditation must still register at CoachAFL and complete the required on-line component). Note: In addition to the on-line course, an optional three hour face-to-face coaching workshop is available. Delivered by expert coaches, the cost associated with this practical three-hour program will be reimbursed by CJFC upon proof of completion. In addition, coaches of female teams may be required to complete an additional face-to-face program. All Camberwell Junior Football Club Coaches and Assistant Coaches must be compliant before the season commences.
